

Can you provide step-by-step instructions to implement the Sexual Misconduct Risk Assessment Grand River Solutions provides for the RMPC program?

If your organization would like to implement the assessment:

1. Go to your Intake Form, which you can find on your RMPC tab in My UE.
2. Select "Sexual Misconduct."
3. Select "Grand River Solutions." Your confirmation message will include contact information for the Grand River Solutions team that will conduct the assessment.
4. After completing the assessment, ask your Grand River Solutions team for an attestation that you completed the assessment.
5. Return to the RMPC tab in My UE and go to the Summary Form.
6. Upload the attestation, which must be dated between the start of your policy year and the RMPC program deadline. You only need to provide UE the attestation — you don't need to upload your assessment results.
7. Click "Submit."
8. After the UE team reviews your attestation, we will award the premium credit and send a confirmation message.

How do I know whether my assessment is eligible for the credit?

Your assessment must be conducted between the start of your policy year and your final RMPC program deadline. Assessments completed in previous years don't qualify for this year's RMPC program.

Does UE or the RMPC program offer a discount on Grand River Solutions?

No. RMPC participation program doesn't offer a pre-purchase discount on any Grand River Solutions service.

When does UE award the premium credit?

UE awards the premium credit after the member uploads its attestation. Members who work on the recommendations in their Grand River Solutions assessment may be able to select other relevant RMPC program activities related to mitigating sexual misconduct risks.

Do UE and Grand River Solutions share my data?

No, and Grand River Solutions won't even know about your membership with UE until you request an attestation. To earn the credit, your institution must notify us that it has completed its assessment. Without that notification, UE won't know your institution implemented the assessment.
